The demand for skilled employees is high and expected to continue, which is great news for people looking to enter the workforce quickly.





## **INVESTING IN YOU**

Investing wisely in your education is important. Ridgewater offers a quality education at an extraordinary value with a variety of ways to help with your educational investment.

#### **TUITION AND FEES**

For fall 2021-22, a credit load of 16 credits per semester will be approximately \$3,154 plus books and other related expenses.

#### **PROGRAM DIFFERENTIAL TUITION RATES PER CREDIT**

Some programs and courses cost more to offer and thus are charged a tuition differential rate.

- Nursing: Associate Degree: \$232.25
- Nursing: Practical Nursing: \$226.25
- Veterinary Technology: \$218.75
  - \* Includes student fees


Minnesota Resident/Non-Resident Tuition and Fees: \$212.60 per credit plus books

#### **OTHER EXPENSES**

Students should plan for other expenses as well. A few things to consider:

- Books
- Rent/utilities/phone
- Food
- Program-specific expenses
- Gas
- Entertainment

Student fees include student services, health services, technology, parking and the Minnesota State College Student Association. They total \$20.85 per credit for 2021-22 for most students. Online students do no pay parking or health services fees.
