
Can you spare 2-4 hours (max!)? Application review is easy and is done entirely online. The timeline for reviews is November 6-9.





challenged me and prepped me for the rest of college. And it was small enough that I developed some great friendships and WCC provided a wonderful college experience.



Christopher Larson: Nursing Student & Scholarship Recipient

"I am from Muscatine, Iowa. I moved to Minnesota in 2016 to get a fresh start on life. I graduated high school in 2009 and went to college for a couple years studying liberal arts and environmental science, but I never finished my degrees. I worked in the restaurant industry from 2009 to 2021, starting as a line cook and working my way up to chef. I was a chef doing corporate dining in 2021 when I got laid off during the pandemic. Around this time, my grandma ended up in

hospice for several months before passing away. I spent lots of time with her and frequently interacted with the nursing staff. I was looking to get out of the restaurant business, and my positive experience at the hospice house led me to decide I wanted to pursue a career in nursing. My dad also worked in healthcare, so I always had that in the back of my mind as an option, but it wasn't until the experience at the hospice house that I decided nursing was for me.

I love going to school at Ridgewater. The small school and class sizes make for a personal educational experience. There is always someone available to answer my questions, and I'm on a first name basis with all of my teachers, advisors and even the library, maintenance, and bookstore staff. I will graduate in December with an ADN, and hopefully start working as an RN shortly after that. I dreamed of changing careers for many years before starting at Ridgewater, and I am grateful for the opportunity to attend a school where I feel seen and where I feel my instructors and people around me care about me and my future.

After graduating I hope to pass the NCLEX and be able to work as an RN as soon as possible. Some areas I'm considering working in are hospice, detox, rehab, or mental health. The ideal situation would be finding a job that will pay for me to continue going to school while I'm working so I can get a BSN."
