Eligibility Requirements for Sophomore PSEO

High school sophomores may enroll in **one career or technical education course** at Ridgewater College for their first semester. Sophomores must meet the following to enroll in a CTE course:

- Attained a reading score of 850 or higher on the 8th grade Minnesota Comprehensive Assessment. (If a student does not have an MCA score, they are eligible to take the Accuplacer reading exam. A score of 220 or higher is required on the Accuplacer test.)
- Meet any other course prerequisites or course enrollment standards established by the College. This includes, but is not limited to assessment test scores, program admission, or other requirements.
- If a student receives a grade of C or better in the course, the student shall be allowed to take additional courses in their second semester. See PSEO Handbook for more information.
