

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Ridgewater's Practical Nursing program is a competitive program that requires a 2-application process. Students initially apply to Ridgewater as pre-nursing students, work on completing their prerequisite courses (semester 1 in the recommended course sequence), and then complete a separate application to the Practical Nursing program (semesters 2-3 in the recommended course sequence).

The Practical Nursing program is competitive and Ridgewater will accept up to 20 students on each campus (Hutchinson & Willmar) each fall semester. Students must apply for the program months in advance:

• Fall Program Start: Complete second application during the previous April 1-June 1 application cycle

Steps to Practical Nursing Program:

- Apply to Ridgewater as a Pre-Nursing student at <u>https://ridgewater.edu/apply</u>
 - If you have earned credits from other institutions, please request that an official transcript be sent from those institutions to Ridgewater.
- Follow instructions you receive from the Admissions office.
- Meet with an advisor to review degree progress and register for prerequisite courses (semester 1 in the recommended course sequence)
- Apply to Practical Nursing program via the online application. Before students can apply:
 - ENGL 1210, BIOL 1080, PSYC 1310, and PRNU 1617 must be **complete** with minimum "C" grades.
 - Students must attend a virtual Nursing Information Session. Students can RSVP for a session at https://ridgewater.edu/nursing
 - Students must be active on the MN Nursing Assistant Registry.
- Once accepted to the Practical Nursing program, the following must be completed before a student can start the nursing courses (semesters 2 & 3 in the recommended course sequence):
 - Return the signed Practical Nursing program contract that is received upon acceptance to the program.
 - Attend Practical Nursing Orientation.
 - Complete all required paperwork provided at orientation.
 - Submit required documentation for clinicals:
 - Proof of vaccinations: MMR, Varicella, Hep B, TDaP, Annual Flu
 - COVID Vaccine Status (Record of vaccination or documentation of no current vaccination)
 - Proof of freedom of Tuberculosis
 - Copy of current American Heart Association Basic Life Support (CPR & AED) Program card/certificate.
