## Nursing AS

Hutchinson & Willmar | Fall or Spring Start | Full Time | 64 Credits

Ridgewater's Nursing AS program is a competitive program that requires a 2-application process. Students initially apply to Ridgewater as pre-nursing students, work on completing their prerequisite courses (semesters 1 & 2 in the recommended course sequence), and then complete a separate application to the Nursing AS program (semesters 3-5 in the recommended course sequence).

The Nursing AS program is competitive and Ridgewater will accept up to 24 students on each campus (Hutchinson & Willmar) each fall and each spring. Students must apply for the program months in advance:

- Fall Program Start: Complete second application during the previous December 1 February 1 application cycle
- Spring Program Start: Complete second application during the previous July 1 September 1 application cycle

#### **Steps to Nursing AS Program:**

- Apply to Ridgewater as a Pre-Nursing student at <a href="https://ridgewater.edu/apply">https://ridgewater.edu/apply</a>
  - If you have earned credits from other institutions, please request that an official transcript be sent from those institutions to Ridgewater.
- o Follow instructions you receive from the Admissions office.
- Meet with an advisor to review degree progress and register for prerequisite courses (semesters 1 & 2 in the recommended course sequence)
- Apply to Nursing AS program via the online application. Before students can apply:
  - PSYC 1310, CHEM 1010, and BIOL 2100 must be complete with minimum "C" grades AND a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 among the three courses.
  - Students must attend a virtual Nursing Information Session. Students can RSVP for a session at https://ridgewater.edu/nursing
  - Students must score a minimum of 58.7 on the ATI TEAS Version 7 test.
- Once accepted to the Nursing AS program, the following must be completed before a student can start the nursing courses (semesters 3, 4, & 5 in the recommended course sequence):
  - Return the signed Nursing AS program contract that is received upon acceptance to the program.
  - Attend Nursing AS Orientation.
  - Complete all required paperwork provided at orientation.
  - Submit required documentation for clinicals:
    - Proof of vaccinations: MMR, Varicella, Hep B, TDaP, Annual Flu
    - COVID Vaccine Status (Record of vaccination or documentation of no current vaccination)
    - Proof of freedom of Tuberculosis
    - Copy of current American Heart Association Basic Life Support (CPR & AED) Program card/certificate.
  - PSYC 1310, CHEM 1010, BIOL 2100, ENGL 1210, PSYC 2630, BIOL 2110, and BIOL 2150 MUST be complete with minimum "C" grades AND a cumulative GPA of 2.5 among the seven courses.
