Score a 58.7+ on the ATI TEAS (Version 7).

Complete Semester One & Semester Two courses with a "C" or higher & earn a cumulative GPA of 2.5+ between those seven courses.

Attend Nursing Student Orientation & submit all required documentation (vaccinations, AHA BLS certification, etc.)
